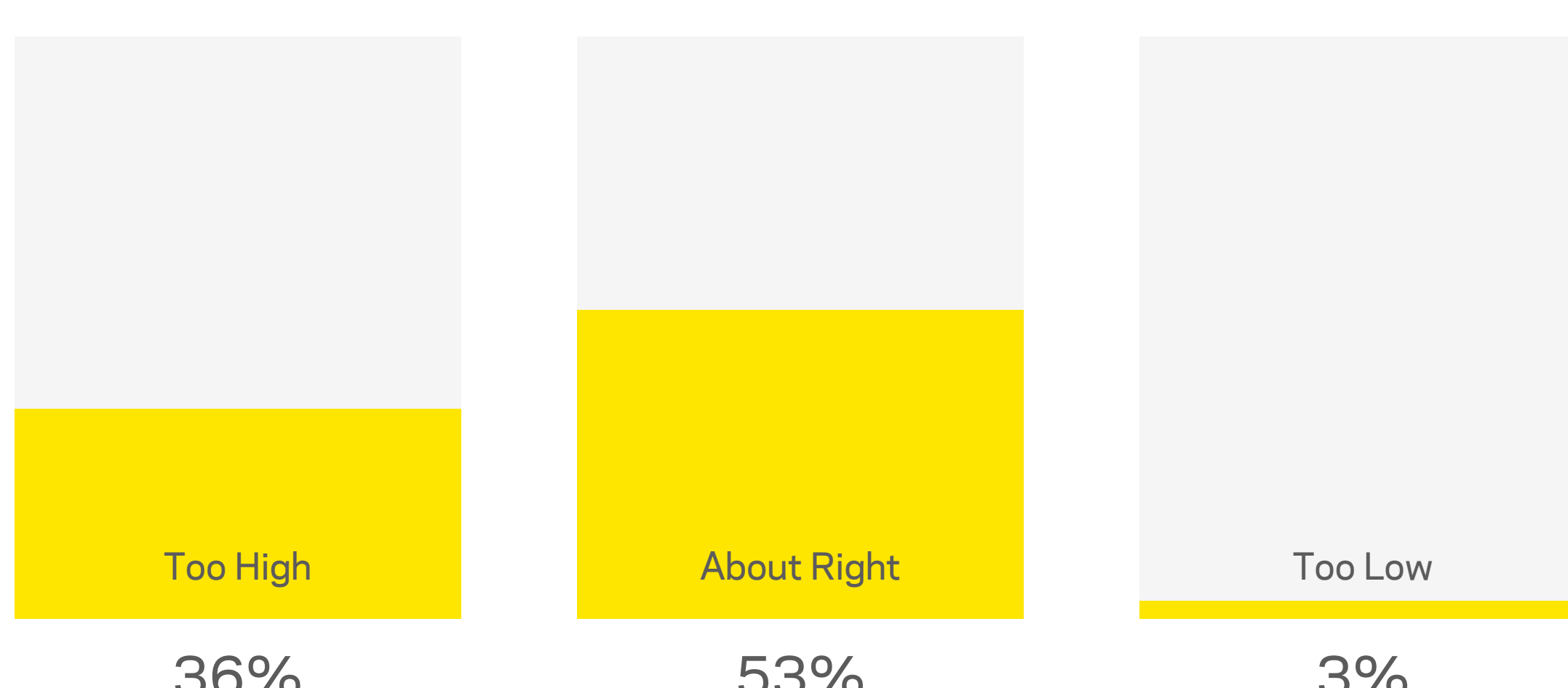


# Millennials & Taxes

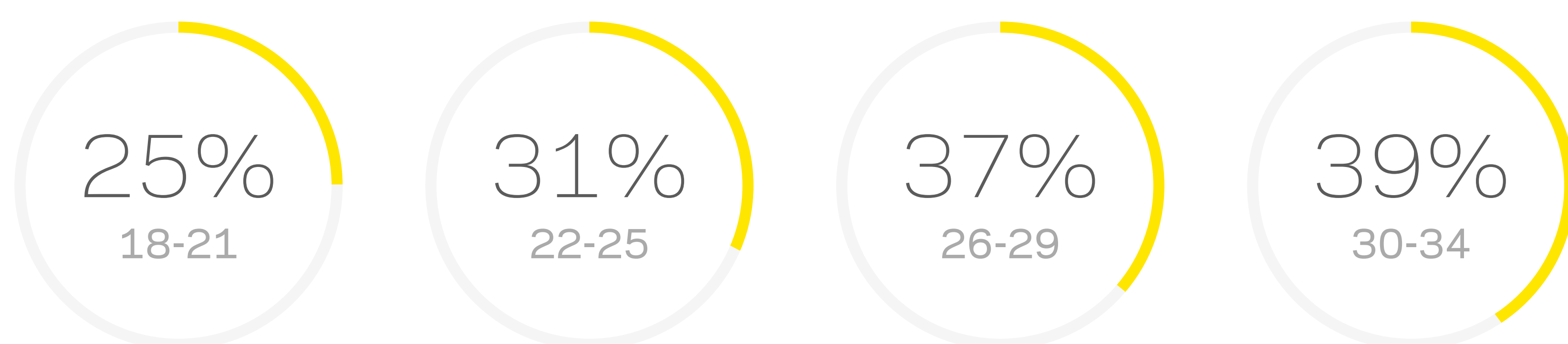
53% of Millennials who filed a tax return believe the amount they paid was about right.

Millennials' assessment of the amount they pay in federal income taxes:



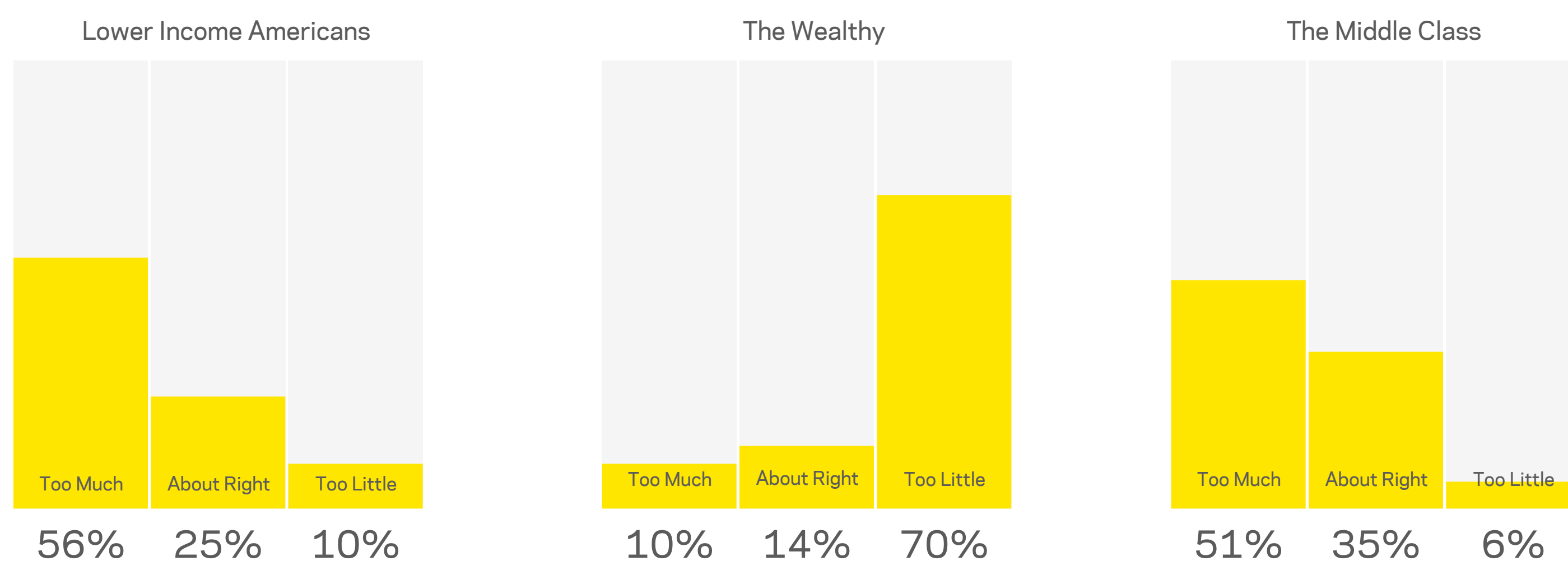
But the older Millennials get, the greater they feel their tax burden increases.

Share of Millennials believing their income taxes are too high by age:



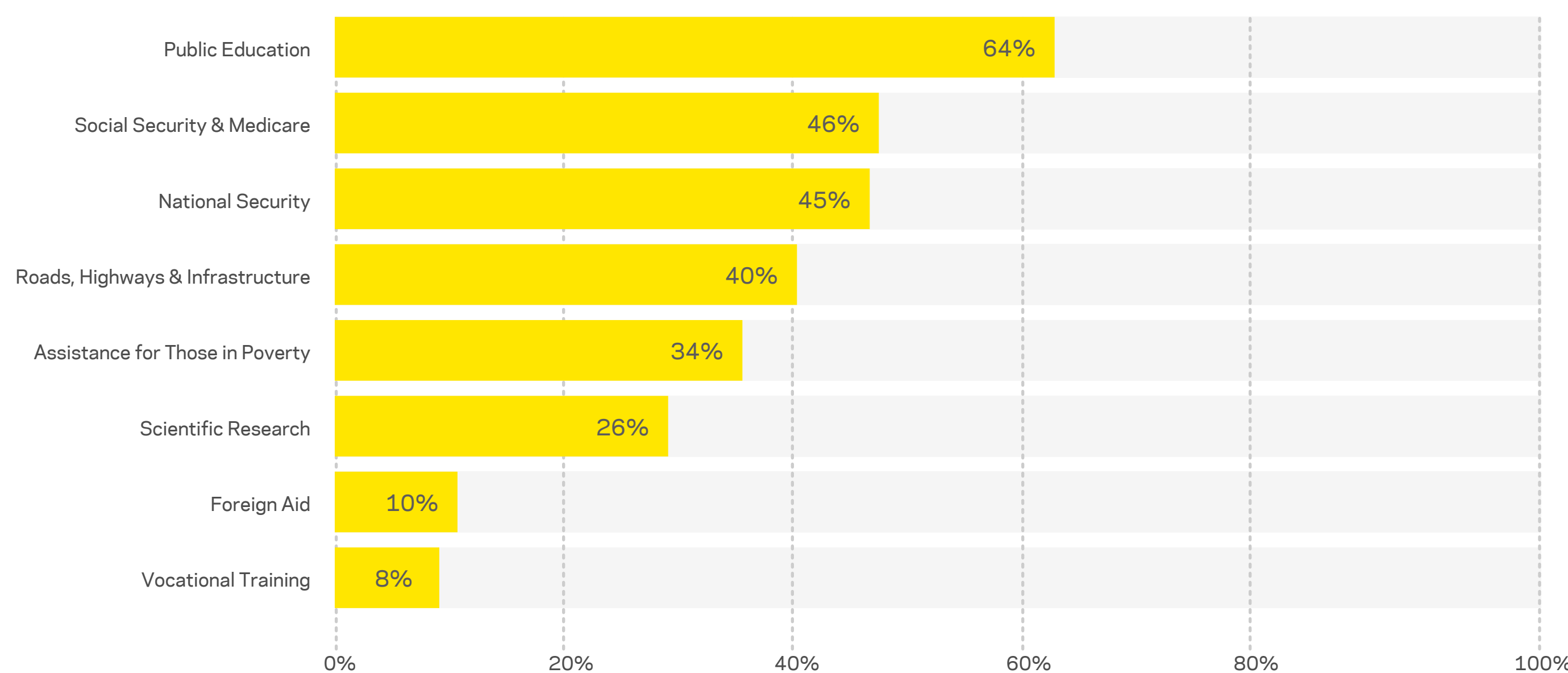
And they're concerned about fairness in the tax system.
